Purpose

While patient-level healthcare databases continue to proliferate globally, the challenge for any healthcare researcher is how to find the optimal database to solve the research question at hand.

Electronic Health Records (EHR), disease registries, claims, and patient-reported surveys individually each have their strengths and weaknesses. Thus, the ideal solution is a combination of fields from one or more databases.

This workshop will address methods for integrating databases from a global perspective, then focus on the healthcare and regulatory landscape of Japan and how integrating databases in this environment is achievable.
